UNIQUE VENUE

The Mifflinburg Buggy Museum is a modern facility surrounded by history. The Museum's Degenstein Auditorium is used for programs, special events and temporary exhibits. The Sheary Gallery holds the Museum exhibit on Mifflinburg and buggy making and can be utilized for theater productions. The Auditorium holds 60-70 people theater style or 32 people classroom style. The Gallery holds 80-90 people theater style.

The Visitors Center is handicapped accessible and contains restrooms, a gift shop and a kitchen. The Museum owns rectangular tables and 75 chairs that can be used at no additional cost. While the Museum does not have an in-house caterer, it has worked with many local restaurants and caterers.

The grounds of the Museum, on both sides of Green Street are also available for use. Alcohol is not permitted in the Museum buildings or on the grounds. Outdoor receptions can be held on the lawn of the Visitor Center and around the historic buildings.
